- Appointments can be made with any of the Medical Clinics online (Patient Portal), by phone or in person. We have a Primary Care Clinic, an Allergy, Immunization & Travel Clinic, Psychiatry Services, and a GYN (Women's) Clinic.

MEDICAL CLINICS & SEAR




MEDICAL CLINICS

- Board-certified & licensed physicians, nurse practitioners, physician assistants, psychiatrists, and specialists.
- Services include general & preventive medical care, psychiatry services, diagnostic services (with on-site lab & x-ray), immunizations, treatment for minor injuries & common illnesses, gynecological health, STI testing, allergy shots, vaccines, nutrition consultations, orthopedic services, and more.

SUBSTANCE EDUCATION & RECOVERY

- Our Substance Education, Assessment & Recovery (SEAR) program
 provides prevention and education trainings, access to the Razorback®
 Recovery Community, weekly recovery meetings, and alcohol/drug
 assessments are performed by an Arkansas licensed professional mental
 health practitioner.
- Our SEAR team is staffed by professionally certified and/or licensed specialists.

BILLING & INSURANCE



Charges vary based on the service provided.

MEDICAL CLINICS

 Medical/psychiatry charges not covered by insurance are billed to the student account (Workday). Self-pay service discount (10%) is available.

SUBSTANCE EDUCATION, ASSESSMENT & RECOVERY (SEAR)

 Substance use & support services include individual and group interventions to university students with alcohol, cannabis, and other substance related concerns. Please contact SEAR for cost of services. All charges for SEAR services are billed to the student account (Workday).




COUNSELING AND PSYCHOLOGICAL SERVICES (CAPS)



CAPS SERVICES OVERVIEW

- Mental health services provided by Counseling & Psychological Services (CAPS) include initial consultations; short-term counseling & psychotherapy; group therapy & workshops; community referrals, and more.
- Most of CAPS' services are **free-of-charge** (included in the Student Health & Wellness Fee).
- To get started with CAPS, students can walk in during business hours (Monday-Thursday 8AM-5PM or Friday 9AM-5PM) or call 479-575-5276 to discuss options. CAPS is located on the 2nd floor of the Pat Walker Health Center.
- CAPS also offers **24-hour emergency mental health services** for students by calling 479-575-5276.





CARE MATCHING MODEL



- At CAPS, our primary focus is on providing short-term,
 confidential counseling aimed at helping students succeed academically and interpersonally.
- To do so, CAPS uses a **Care Matching Model** designed to identify an **individualized plan** to promote student autonomy and empowerment in planning their care (*see model image*).



LANE MARRS RELAXATION ROOM



- The Lane Marrs Relaxation Room is one of our most popular spaces and a valuable resource for students. Designed to provide a safe and calming environment, this room helps students quiet their minds, reduce stress, and reconnect with a sense of tranquility.
- The room is open during normal business hours and students do not have to be clients at CAPS to use the room.
- The **room offers**: comfortable seating, massage chairs, soft lighting, relaxing music, yoga mats, meditation cushions, and noise cancelling headphones (ask someone at the CAPS desk).



- Functional and modern locker rooms






