U of A's exclusive **medical, mental health** and **substance use and support facility**

- PWHC is open **Mondays-Thursdays 8 a.m.-5 p.m.** and **Fridays 9 a.m.-5 p.m.** **In-person and virtual visits allowed**, with the visit-type matched to the service being provided.
- Appointments may be made with any of the **Medical Clinics** online (**Patient Portal**), **by phone, or in person.**
- Students interested in getting started with **Counseling & Psychological Services (CAPS)** may walk in **during business hours** or call **479-575-5276** to discuss options.
- Appointments may be made with **Substance Education, Assessment & Recovery (SEAR)** online (**Patient Portal**) or by emailing **sear@uark.edu**.




PRIORITIZE YOUR WELL-BEING

MEDICAL SERVICES

- **Board-certified and licensed** physicians, nurse practitioners, physician assistants, psychiatrists, and specialists.
- **Services include** general and preventive medical care, psychiatry services, diagnostic services (with on-site lab and X-ray), immunizations, treatment for minor injuries and common illnesses, gynecological health, STI testing, allergy shots, vaccines, nutrition/dietitian consultations, orthopedic services, travel consultations, behavioral health counseling (BHC), and more.

SUBSTANCE USE and SUPPORT SERVICES

- **Substance Education, Assessment & Recovery (SEAR)** provides substance education and prevention, direct individual and group interventions, access to the Razorback[®] Recovery Community (peer support group), and more.
- **Alcohol/drug assessments** are conducted by an Arkansas-licensed mental health practitioner.



MENTAL HEALTH - CAPS

- CAPS is **located on the second floor** of the Pat Walker Health Center.
- **Mental health services** provided by **Counseling & Psychological Services (CAPS)** include initial consultations, short-term counseling and psychotherapy, group therapy and workshops, community referrals, and more. Most of CAPS services are **covered by the Student Health & Wellness Fee**.
- CAPS offers **24-hour emergency mental health services** for students **by calling 479-575-5276**. Same-day crisis appointments also are available during business hours.
- **The Lane Marris Relaxation Room** offers a safe and relaxing space for students to reduce stress and reconnect with quiet and tranquility. The room is open during normal business hours and **students do not have to be clients at CAPS to use the room**.



BILLING & INSURANCE

Charges vary based on services provided.



MEDICAL SERVICES

- **Medical/psychiatry charges not covered by insurance are billed to the student account (Workday).** Reference lab charges are billed separately by the performing lab. A **self-pay service discount (10%) is available** for those uninsured. Contact our billing team at **479-575-4452, option 6, with questions.**

COUNSELING & PSYCHOLOGICAL SERVICES (CAPS)

- **Most mental health services are free** (included in the Student Health & Wellness Fee).

SUBSTANCE EDUCATION, ASSESSMENT & RECOVERY (SEAR)

- **Substance use and support services** include individual and group interventions to university students with alcohol, cannabis, and other substance-related concerns. Please contact SEAR for cost of services. **All charges for SEAR services are billed to the student account (Workday).**

BILLING WITH INSURANCE

- Check with your **insurance provider to see if a medical provider at PWHC is in-network.** A **student health insurance plan** also is available for purchase.




